First, one of them chooses a word or phrase for the puzzle. He also draws a dash for each letter in the puzzle, leaving a space between words. Then he draws the gallows above the dashes. Then, the other player guesses letters one at a time, that they think that is in the secret word or phrase. If they guess right, the player who did the puzzle, writes in the letter, over any corresponding dashes. If they guess wrong, the player who did the puzzle draws the head hanging off the Gallows and mark the incorrect letter for the guessing player to use as a reference. Every time the player who is guessing picks a wrong letter, another part of the body part is added to the Hangman. The Hangman should comprise a head, a body, two arms, and two legs. In case, the guessing player effectively guesses the puzzle or fills in all the letters before the Hangman is complete, they win. If they do not, the player who came up with the puzzle wins. Once a player wins, they exchange roles so that the guessing player from the last round is presently the player coming up with the puzzle.
